## Temporary Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ)



The temporary Controlled Parking Zones (CPZ) in G01 and G02 came to an end, as soon as the Paralympics closed, on 10 September. However towards the end of September the council will be carrying out a consultation exercise to see if we wish to keep the CPZ or not. Whatever your views the Focus Team encourages everybody to respond to the consultation.



CPZ's tend to be set up around shopping centres, as at the Thatched House, where shoppers like to park, or near rail and tube stations, where commuters like to park before going on from the station. These conditions do not apply in Cann Hall where parking in the road is by local residents. Do we really need a CPZ where we will have to pay to park?

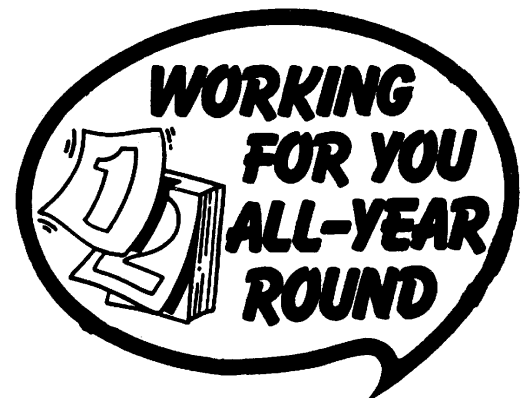
