### Electrification of the Barking - Gospel Oak Line

New bridges are being installed along the **Barking-Gospel Oak line**, which runs through our Ward, to prepare to electrify the line. Transport for London (TFL) has pledged £25m towards this work and the Government the rest, a total of £90m.

Longer trains are needed to alleviate daily overcrowding but new diesel trains are uneconomical.

Cllr Liz Phillips has already had course to complain to Network Rail about Health and Safety issues around the Lansdowne Road Bridge.
