Council Continues to Spend Your Money

Recent Freedom of Information figures have highlighted that Waltham Forest Labour-run Council spent a massive £279,000 on the Olympic Torch relay. Wandsworth spent only £710.14. This was the second highest in the country and seven times more than the average across Britain.

This is after spending £650,000 of rate payer's money on a new entrance to the Town Hall in Walthamstow and over £18,700 on new tables for the committee rooms.

The plans included removing one engine from each station in Leytonstone, Leyton and Chingford.

Recently the council's planning committee refused planning permission to turn the old police station in the **High Road** into a school for Muslim girls.

This was due to lack of outside playing space and no disability access for the upper floors.

Cllr Liz Phillips said, "It's back to the drawing board."

8 Winchelsea Road

During 2012 the council's planning department turned down a planning application to



convert **8 Winchelsea Road** into 5 self-contained flats (2 x 1 bed and 3 x studios).

The developers 'Exterior Plas' appealed the decision.

Cllr Liz Phillips wrote to the Planning Inspectorate asking them to uphold the council's decision and refuse the appeal. Unfortunately the inspector allowed the appeal.
