Leytonstone Police Station to be axed

Local residents in Leyton and Leytonstone will be shocked to learn that their only remaining local Police Station in **Kirkdale Road** has been closed.

The Police Station in **Francis Road** was closed on the understanding that the Leytonstone station would stay open.

Focus is told that the local police team are using the custody suite off Hainault Road. **Focus** is appalled that the police have let down local residents who are rightly concerned about the safety of their families and their homes.

Focus Team member Rupert Alexander says: 'It would appear that residents object to these closures; local Police Stations are part of the community; alternative local provision in Leytonstone needs to be looked at and residents consulted."



Free school meals to save families £400 per child

Thousands of Leyton and Leytonstone children have begun receiving a free, healthy lunchtime meal since returning to school this September.

Local Liberal Democrat Clyde Kitson said, "This is one of the most important changes to our education system for a generation, and I am delighted that the Lib Dems in government have delivered it. "Free school meals will improve children's education by improving concentration, making sure they have a healthier diet, and save parents money – as much as £400 per child."

Real benefits in the classroom

This **Lib Dem** success has been five years in the making with successful pilot schemes reaping real benefits in the classroom. Students were found on average to be two months ahead of their peers in areas where school meals were not offered.
