Landjords Take Heed!!

Since April 1st this year all privately rented properties in Waltham Forest need to be licenced as Waltham Forest Council is now a Private Rented Property Licensing (PRPL) area.

If you are a Landlord in Waltham Forest you need a licence for each property that you rent out and not doing so could result in prosecution.

Are you a tenant living in a private rented property in Waltham Forest?

Licensing will benefit tenants by providing clear minimum standards for rented housing and will enable the Council to identify and take action against bad landlords.

Focus Team member Liz Phillips says; 'If you are privately renting find out if your property has a licence, ask your landlord or managing agent to provide you with the licence number, if not contact the council 020 8496 3000.
